New MSIP 6 Compliant CSIP is Completed and Approved

In the Spring of 2025, district staff, students, and community members began the process of updating the newest cycle of the Comprehensive School Improvement Plan. Community data were analyzed and decision on areas of growth and focused resources were made for the next three years of operations. The Missouri Department of Elementary and Secondary Education have audited the work and approved the updated plan. Please [follow the link](#) to this important school document.

Financial “Tight Times” ahead for Missouri School Districts

The 2026 Missouri legislative session focused heavily on state and local school budgets after many proposals failed to pass. Public schools were already underfunded by an estimated \$138 million in FY26, with FY27 proposals adding another \$190 million foundation formula shortfall and \$15 million in transportation cuts. Combined, Missouri schools now face an estimated \$362.7 million funding gap. Districts will closely monitor DESE updates on funding, transportation, teacher salary grants, and career ladder programs as budgets are finalized. These revenue shortfalls create a very fiscally conservative approach to school finance of the next few years.

Work Is Underway for Proposition 2 Projects

Demolition of the track facility began on June 1st. There will be several weeks of excavation and grading work prior to the beginning of construction. Completion of the track and field complex is estimated for early November. Bids have been collected for the replacement of five aged Roof Top Units (RTUs) for building climate control. Additionally, sample drawings, price quotes, and grant applications have been collected for the Elementary/Middle School Playground upgrades.
