

## BELL GAME ACTIVITIES, EVENTS, & GAME September 4<sup>th</sup>, 2020

In an effort to help mitigate the potential spread of COVID-19, the Marceline R-V Schools have initiated the following measures during the 2020 Bell Game festivities. While we regret having to deviate from the traditional activities surrounding this week, we are attempting to do our part to ensure students can participate in these activities in as safe of an environment as possible. It is our hope that by following these recommendations, our students, staff, parents and community members can avoid another school closure due to an increase in community spread.

- BON-FIRE, Wednesday, September 2<sup>nd</sup> at 7:00 PM
  - The bon-fire will be restricted to Marceline R-V Students and required personnel and staff only.
- ASSEMBLY, Friday, September 4th
  - The assembly will be restricted to Marceline R-V Students and required personnel and staff only. The assembly will be livestreamed at 2:30 PM. A link will be available on the district website at www.marcelineschools.org or on the Marceline R-V Schools Facebook page.

## • FFA COOK-OFF

- $\circ$  The two schools will work together instead of competing.
- Meals will be prepacked.
- The community members will have the option of two different meals.
- Meals will be served, "to go", out of the Ag Shop. There will be no seating offered.

## • GAME GUIDELINES

- **GATE:** There will be a home and visitor gate. Please use each team designated gate.
- SOCIAL DISTANCING: The Marceline R-V School District recommends that you sit with your immediate family members and maintain a distance of six feet at all times from other spectators whenever possible.
- MASK RECOMMENDATION- The Marceline R-V School District recommends that you wear a mask that covers your nose and mouth any time you are not able to maintain six feet of social distancing between yourself and other spectators at any athletic or extra- curricular event.
- SEATING: Marceline Fans will have access to the North bleachers and West end zone, Brookfield fans will have access to the South bleachers and East end zone. We further recommend that you bring your own seating (lawn chairs) to assist in this process. This will help with social distancing and prevent over-crowding in the bleachers.
- **FUND RAISERS:** To avoid large groups congregating, organizations will not be allowed to set up fund-raising tables inside the facility.
